Well-known tenor Sipan Olah was a special Armenian guest among international destinguished musicians from the UK, Russia, Argentina, China and the Philippines on 29 February at the official opening night of international "Stars of The Albion. Grand Prix 2020" Festival-contest in

Russian Culture House, Kensington, London. He

performed "Spring waters" by S. Rackmaninov and "Sing for me" by Al. Harutiunyan accompanied by the director, president of the international festival-contest, pianist Evgenia Terentieva. The next day **Mr Olah was a jury member** presenting Armenia & the UK with other international jury members from 24 countries.



1ST PLACE AND GOLDEN AWARD IN LONDON, UK



It is with great pleasure that KCCA wants to share fantastic news that Soprano Hayarpi Yeghikyan won the 1st Place and Golden Award in the Classical solo singing category at the 7th International Performing Arts Festival & Contest "Stars of the Albion" London, UK.

Hayarpi presented Armenia among 95 participants from

24 countries. The contest took place from 28 February to 1 March 2020. Hayarpi performed two beautiful and technically challenging arias. The first one was the aria of Magda "Chi il bel sogno" from the opera "La rondine" by G.Puccini. The second aria was "Se tu m'ami" by A.Parisotti. The musical notes range of both arias was nearly 3 octaves!
